Doug has been working with Penton Imports for four years at which time he has held the positions of Service Manager, Sales Manager and Riding Coach. Doug has been riding enduros for many years and has pulled down his share of the wins. While traveling with and coaching the Penton Trophy Team in 1972, he won the Bad Rock 2-Day Trials and several gold medals in the 2-Day ISDT qualifiers. Douglas has been trained in every facet of the selling, servicing and distribution of the Penton cycles and being an active competitor, is well informed on the racing aspect of our business.





FROM THE PROBLEM SHOP Ted Penton

The annual motorcycle shows and dealers' schools tell us that it will soon be Daytona time.

Two weeks ago I visited the motorcycle show in Long Beach, California. The enthusiasm shown by the dealers' network on the West Coast was very encouraging for the future year and it looks like our sales this year will be ahead of our production in spite of our increase.

The problems that come in to us at R & D haven't increased with our sales, so that clearly demonstrates that we must be improving our quality.

Our Dane Leimbach has been on top of our Motoplat complaints and they have decreased by half in the last 2 months. There again demonstrating the success of the quality control at Motoplat.

We still get a few carburetor complaints, a few piston complaints, but they have diminished as the months go by.

On our last tour thru the South we heard a few complaints of our transmission again. In tracing these we find they are all from magazine articles. Publishers don't take them apart, they don't have any trouble with them either, they go by hearsay from years gone past when nobody understood these transmissions.

The Sach's gear box is the lightest, most faultless, most rugged and easiest shifting on the market. Any transmission that is stronger than this one is heavier than this one and when they are heavier they shift harder. There is not another transmission on the market today that comes apart and goes together as easy as the Sach's box. It has a postitive lock when it is shifted, and it is impossible to shift it more than 1 gear at a time. Our servicemen can prove this to you right here.

Any dealer in this country who wishes to come to our R & D Center will leave here with perfect understanding of the transmission and he will say the same thing as we do - it is the best gear box on the market today.

True that Sach's designed it, but Penton developed it. I personally traveled the length and breadth of this country and worked on them in every conceivable condition. I brought all these problems back and took them to Germany. Sach's took our advice and the results are as perfect as they can be built.

There are accessories on the market today they call positive lock additions for the Sach's transmission. It is true that some of these old style boxes can be improved with these accessories. However, the ones that have been sold in the last 3 years are positive lock transmissions, and there is nothing you can do to make them any better if they are assembled properly.

Oh, don't take me wrong, they can be smashed, but when you do, you are using it contrary to the way it was built to be used, and we don't say that it was built to be babied.

We hope to get this letter in your hands before our dealers' school, and if we do, we hope you'll bring any problems from your transmissions in here with you. Above all, we hope you will be here. It is one of the happiest moments of our year to see the people who have made us what we are and who pay our bills — you dealers. Come and see our shop, our warehouse and all of our people and take back with you anything that we can do to improve your business.





We also have indoor single-faced illuminated signs 16" x 36" for Hi-Point Oils and Accessories. Get your orders in now for these signs.


RACING MOTOPLATS FOR BULTACOS AND YAMAHAS



All orders received by our Penton East office no later than Friday the 9th of February, 5:30 P.M. will be delivered at the old price, providing we have these bikes in stock. No back orders will be filled at the old price. All dealers attending Service School can pick up their bikes at the old price. I can only tell you dealers, that if you are coming to Dealers' School, you are nuts if you don't pick up bikes. Example . . . If a man drives from Florida and picks up five 125cc bikes in a van, he immediately saves \$200.00 on the price increase and approximately \$100.00 on freight charges. A \$300.00 savings. He's made himself a half week's wages and paid for the trip to Service School.

This is not a gimmick to get you to come to Service School; Lord knows we have enough people coming to Dealers' School. But, we want to keep you posted on the price bit, so you don't get "teed" off with us. Furthermore, this price increase is announced for the Penton East Dealers and not for Penton Central and Penton West.

It is inevitable that the prices at Central and West are going up very soon, but again, they are farther at the end of the line. So their prices may be a little later than the East, because those bikes they have were purchased at the old price.

You will have to keep in touch with your distributor on price increases and when. I do know their prices will vary some from the East, because of freights etc. Again, we have been perfectly fair about the crazy price increase business, inasmuch as we have only passed on this increase as it came to us.

The indicators all tell us we are going to have a tremendous dirt bike year. We are going to try our very best to better satisfy each and every dealer this year. It is for this reason that we want you to attend our Service Schools and learn firsthand of our efforts.

We have good sound new accessory products and have still bettered our services to you. We now have much larger warehousing facilities, along with larger back-up stocks. Again come to Dealers' School and see for yourself.

At the same time meet our entire staff. We know you will be assured of a good year working with these enthusiastic people.

Penton Central and Penton West — will keep you posted on their schools, which I think will be in the near future.

The Winter Series M-X is under way in the South. This series will conclude at Daytona during Speedweek with a \$10,000 purse. This is way up from last year's poor purse of \$2,500 with about 20,000 fans in the Speedweek bowl.
